ELEVEN DIVE FORMAT – PIAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

- ◆ The PIAA State Diving Championships will follow the 2023-24 NFHS Swimming and Diving Rules found on pages 79-80 of the NFHS Rules Book.
- Twenty-four divers shall compete in 2A Girls, 2A Boys, 3A Girls and 3A Boys.
- The Swimming and Diving Championships Memo contains a chart showing the "Maximum Number of Diving Entries (Qualifiers) to the 2023-24 PIAA Swimming and Diving Championships." This information is also contained in the 2023-24 PIAA Rules and Regulations, page 32.
- ◆ Page 76 of the NFHS Rules Book. Art. 5. "In Championship meets, this scoresheet shall be submitted to the meet committee at the specified time and place with changes permitted until 60-minutes prior to the start of the diving competition. Correction of errors noted by the diving referee shall be permitted until the start of the diving competition."
- The top 16 divers will score points for their respective teams and the top eight divers will medal.

Note: All diving registrations will be held in the Control Room at the Natatorium.
