- ◆ The PIAA Diving Championships will follow the 2024-25 NFHS Swimming and Diving Rules found on pages 72-93 of the NFHS Rules Book.
- Twenty-four (24) divers shall compete in 2A Girls, 2A Boys, 3A Girls and 3A Boys.
- ◆ The Swimming and Diving Championships Memo contains a chart showing the "Maximum Number of Diving Entries (Qualifiers) to the 2024-25 PIAA Swimming and Diving Championships." This information is also contained in the 2024-25 PIAA Rules and Regulations, page 34.
- ♦ Page 76 of the 2025 NFHS Rules Book. Art. 5. "In Championship meets, this scoresheet shall be submitted to the meet committee at the specified time and place with changes permitted until 60-minutes prior to the start of the diving competition. Correction of errors noted by the diving referee shall be permitted until the start of the diving competition."
- The top sixteen (16) divers will score points for their respective teams and the top eight (8) divers will medal.
